Settlement of the Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) Lawsuit and Implementation of Community-Based Adult Services (CBAS)

Stakeholder Webinar

WHAT:

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) will conduct a stakeholder webinar session regarding the settlement of the Adult Day Health Care (ADHC) lawsuit and the implementation of the new Community-Based Adult Services (CBAS) program.

The purpose of the webinar is to outline the major provisions of the settlement that resolved a challenge to the elimination of the optional ADHC benefit, and to provide information about the implementation pathway for CBAS. Under the settlement, the ADHC benefit will be eliminated effective February 29, 2012. The CBAS program, which will provide necessary medical and social services to those with the greatest need, will begin on March 1, 2012.
