HOME AND COMMUNITY-BASED (HCB) SETTINGS FEDERAL REQUIREMENTS AFFECTING COMMUNITY-BASED ADULT SERVICES (CBAS)

The California Department of Aging (CDA) and the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) want you to know about the federal Home and Community-Based (HCB) Settings requirements that affect CBAS providers and participants. The following are some examples of these requirements:

All CBAS Centers must meet CBAS participants' needs in the following ways:

- Protect participants' privacy and treat participants with dignity and respect.
- Support participants' right to make choices, including choices about the services they receive and who provides them.
- Support participants having full access to and staying connected with the community in which they live.
- Enable participants (and whomever else the participant chooses) to participate in planning the CBAS services they receive at the center to meet their needs and preferences.
- Enable participants to access all public areas of the center including bathrooms, activity rooms, tables, chairs.
